



**EXPLANATION OF GIFT AGREEMENT
HARRY P. WEBER UNIVERSITY ARCHIVES
& FLORIDA TECH SPECIAL COLLECTIONS**

The Agreement acknowledges the gift and provides a brief description of the contents (this description may be undertaken by either the donor or the Archives).

The Agreement assigns copyright to Florida Tech. Any items created by you and not already published are your literary property. If researchers wish to quote your writings, they must first obtain permission from the copyright holder or heirs. This can be difficult for the researcher and inconvenient for the copyright holder. In order to facilitate the process of research, we ask donors to assign copyright to Florida Tech to save donors the time and effort of responding to future researchers. It also allows us to digitize your materials to provide better access or serve preservation needs.

The Agreement describes the activities for which Florida Tech intends to use your collection.

Disposal of Items: Because of limited space and budget constraints, the Archives must evaluate the contents of each collection and may elect not to keep certain items. You may specify if you would like items that are not accessioned into the collection returned to you. The Archives will also provide you with quality copies of select items upon request. You have access to your donation at any time (during business hours) even if it is not yet made available to other researchers.

This Agreement applies to any future gifts you may give to Florida Tech. This clause states that any future donations will fall under the same conditions as this one.
